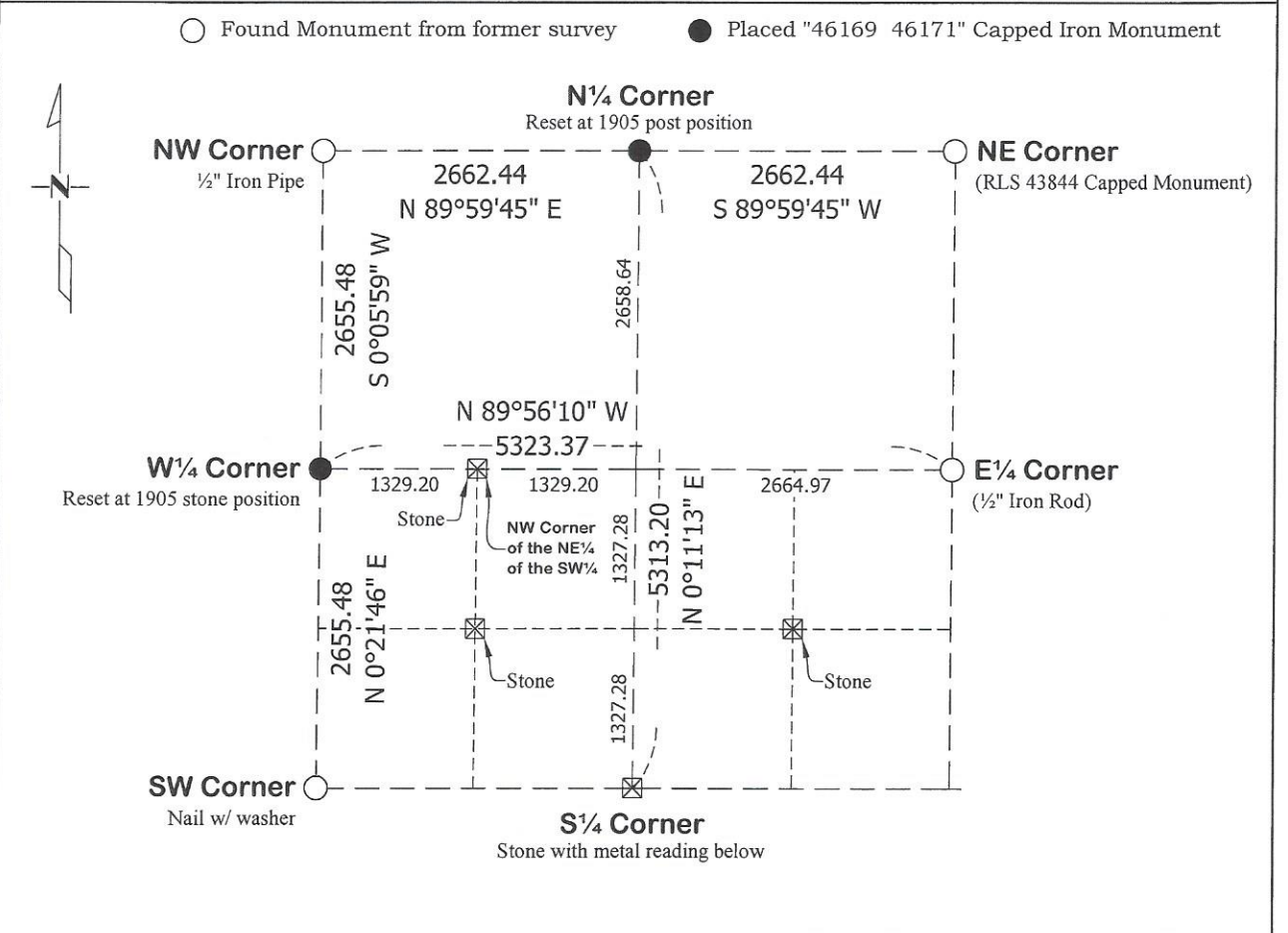

Made at the request of Herman Schmidt, Emel Bricktruty on Nov. 13th 1905, and whom whom my Assistant with some others at times, Beginning at a stone sunk in S.W. corner of Sec 25 marked + from thence run East at 100 ft enter Slough at 900 ft leave Slough, at 1320 ft set trial 1/8 Sec. cor. at 2000 ft opposite Schmidt house, at 2640 ft set trial S. 1/4 Sec. cor. of Sec 25 old corner lost. Thence went to the 1/4 Sec. cor. between Sec. 25 & 26 old known corner fixed it up thus: dug a pit 32 inches deep and deposit 2 Binder guards & glass & China ware & two wards bottles & sunk a stone on top, size 2.3 X 10 X 8" marked + witness, J. B. Doyle, Ernest Birkholz, Herman Schmidt, R. J. Schmidt, this 1/4 S. C. was 2655 ft. or 15 ft excess, from the S.W. cor of Sec 25, thence run north at 5310 ft intersect N. West Sec. cor. of S. 25 a marked Stone +, Thence run East from N.W. cor. at 2640 chs set trial N. 1/4 Sec. cor. of S. 25, old cor. lost, then East at 5324 1/2 ft. intersect N.E. Cor. of S. 25 old cor. fixed it up thus: sunk a pit in place about 24" deep, set a pint bottle in corner, deposited glass & dishes and set old stone on top size 2.7 X 19 X 12" marked ^{hole} 25" Witness Emel Bricktruty, Herman Schmidt, Ernest Birkholz, Charles Anderson, J. B. Doyle, From said north East Cor. run South at 2658 1/3 ft intersect old 1/4 Sec. cor. 2 rods west of the corner tree in grove, size of Stone 2.0 X 14 X 11" marked + oak Post under and

N. 1/4 Sec. 16, T. 26 N., R. 12 E., S. 25. Old cor. east, then east at 5332 1/2 ft. Intersect N. 1/4 Sec. 16, S. 25.

Old cor. first set up thus: sunk a pit in place about 24" deep, set a pint bottle in corner, deposited glass

and set old stone on top sig 27 X 19 X 12" marked 0 25" witness Emil Brickkraby, Herman Schmidt, Ernst

Birkholz, Charles Anderson, J. B. Doyle, from said north east cor. run south at 2658 1/3 ft intersect

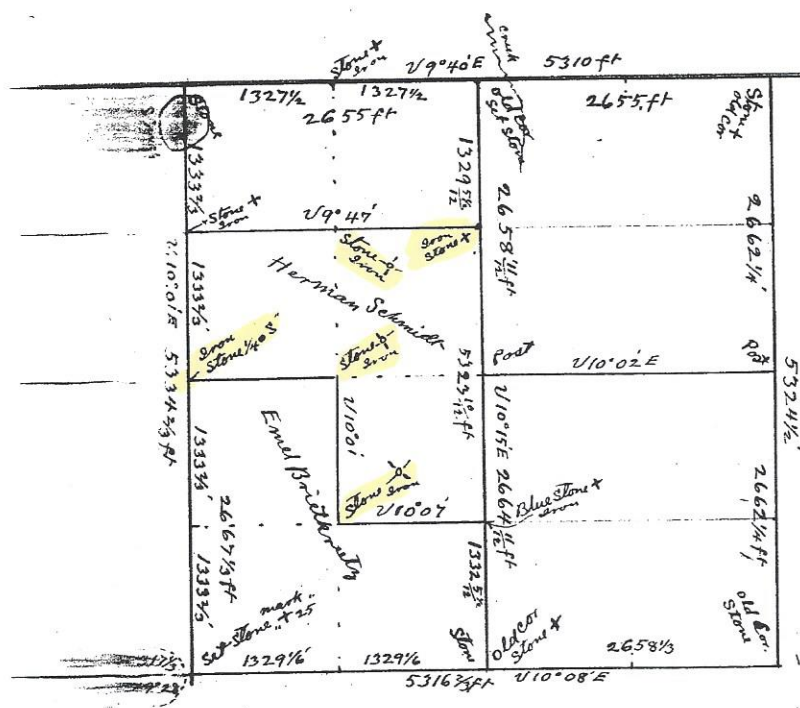
old 1/4 Sec. 16, 2 rods west of the corner tree in grove, sig of stone 20 X 14 X 11" marked + oak post under and

broken glass X disks around N. 1/4 Sec. 16, Nov 15 - dug all day for 3 1/2 cor. of sec 25, nothing found, Nov 16 dug for south 1/4 Sec. cor of sec. 25 - nothing found, then went and commenced at town cor. Stone S.E. cor. of sec 36, marked N.E. S. 1, 113, R. 36, from Thoma

run N. 1/4 Sec. 16 at 2640 ft place for 1/4 Sec. 16, nothing found, Thoma N. at 3960 ft. Along N. of east 281 ft Thoma run north at 5300 ft then west 281 ft at East line, then north at 5317 1/2 ft. From north, then stop place north on other corner, on town line, Nov 17 set a stone at S.E. cor. sig 31 1/2 X 16 X 14" marked + 25" sunk a bottle in town corner under said stone with a paper inside dated Nov 17 - 1905 - witness the names of witnesses present: J. B. Johnson Co. Surveyor and Charles Anderson, Ernest Brickkraby, and S. J. Comer - is 30 ft north

Schmidt Emil Brickkraby, and S. J. Comer - is 30 ft north of the phone pole. Thoma went to East south 1/4 Sec. cor. of sec 25, dug a pit at the highway place between sec. corners drove a 1/2 inch iron rod 16 inches long, deposited broken disks around iron, set stone on top marked 1/4 0 5" - sig 20 X 12 X 8 1/2" - Thoma went to the 1/6 Sec. on south line of SW 1/4. Then sunk a pit and drove a 1/2 inch iron rod 11 inches long with a loop on the end, deposited broken disks around the rod - set a stone on top sig 24 X 8 X 7" marked - 1/4 - Then to 1/6 Sec. on N. side of SW 1/4 dug pit drove 8" casting and broken disks around iron, stone sig 22 X 14 X 11" marked + - Nov 18. Then to 1/6 Sec. on N. line of SW 1/4 sunk pit drove a machine guard, broken glass X disks around it, set stone on top sig 18 X 11 X 12" marked + Then to 1/6 Sec. on N. side of S.E. 1/4 sunk pit drove guard, from glass. Chain went, set a blue stone sig 12 X 18 X 18" marked + Then to center 1/6 Sec. of S.E. 1/4 sunk pit drove guard in place, 1 hour shot X glass, set stone, sig 24 X 20 X 16" marked - 1/4. Then to 1/6 Sec. between SW 1/4 and SE 1/4 dug pit drove a 1/2 inch iron rod 18" long, and a beer bottle in place for corner set stone on top sig 14 X 16 X 10 1/2" marked - 9" Then to the center 1/6 Sec. of S.W. 1/4 sunk pit drove 3/16" iron rod 18" long and a brown bottle

Sunk stone on top sig 18 X 19 X 9" marked - 9"

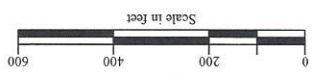

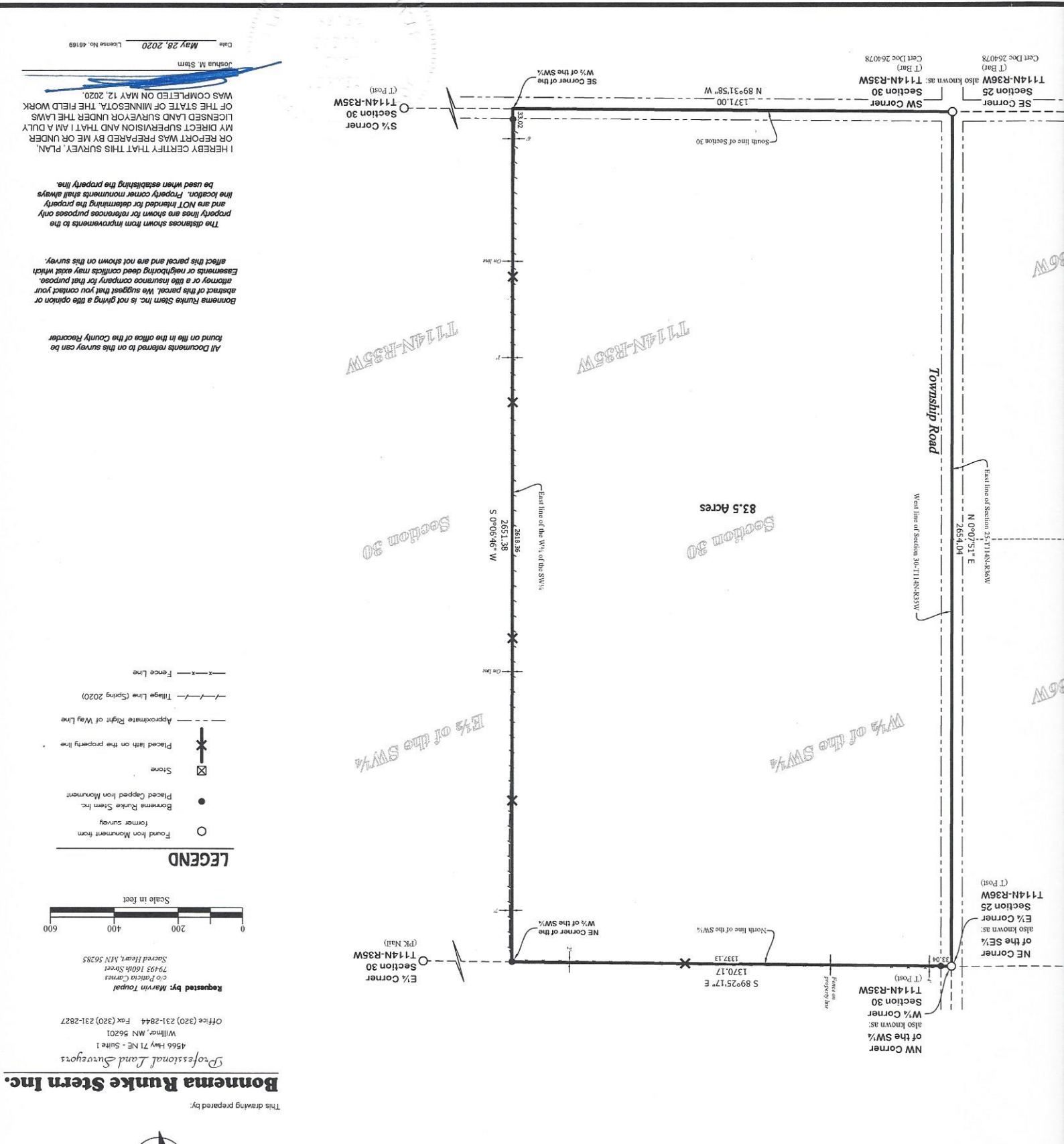
