


DUCK-CALL.

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

To whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ELAM FISHER, of Detroit, in the county of Wayne and State of Michigan, have invented a new and useful Improvement in "Duck-Call;" and I do declare that the following is a true and accurate description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying drawings and to the letters of reference marked thereon, and being a part of this specification.

Figure 1 is a perspective view of my apparatus. Figure 2 is a vertical section of the same.

Like letters indicate like parts in each figure.

The nature of this invention relates to the construction of an implement for the use of sportsmen and hunters in duck-hunting.

It consists of a reed instrument of peculiar construction, as more fully hereinafter described.

In the accompanying drawings-

A represents two sections, each being alike, of semicircular pieces of wood, concave on the inside, while the upper ends of the outer sides are rounded off, as shown.

Between these two sections, the concave sides of which fit together, is fitted a thin reed, B, of sheet copper preferably, which in its shape conforms to the shape of the sections on a line through their center.

The opposite ends of the sections A and reed B are inclosed in the upper end of a bell-mouth or conically-shaped mouth, C, which is made of bone or horn, turned off, inside and out, thin, to give the necessary tone to the instrument, to produce as perfect an imitation of the quack or call of a wild duck as is possible.
